SECTION 1 – GROWTH GROUP QUESTIONS

1. If Moses' parents hadn't had faith of their own, what kind of life do you think Moses would have led? Do you believe God would still have worked through him?
2. Moses could have made the decision to stay in his life in Egypt but chose "faith" over luxury. What do you think drove him to make this decision?
3. Moses' actions in killing the Egyptian and reprimanding the Israelites who were fighting (Exodus 2:11-15) caused him to be hunted by the Pharaoh and ridiculed by his own people. We are told Moses became afraid and ran away. Have you ever done the right thing in your life only to be condemned by others? If so, when and how?
4. Have you ever done something and run away from the consequences not knowing where God is leading you but with faith are willing to suffer for Christ?

5. If God asked you today to leave all of your earthly treasures and pick up and follow him into the desert, what would your honest response be?
